## PREFACE

We present this first expanded edition of the Missionary Prayer Handbook, in the hope that the new layout will help to give a clearer understanding of the work being done on the various foreign fields, and enable us to pray more intelligently for those who need our prayer so much.

The missionaries' names are listed in the area, city, or mission station in which they work, so that all those working in one area are listed together. Then follows a very brief sketch of the total work done there. We have also added the number of missionary co-workers, and commended national men, either for the area, or the whole country, where this is known. The number of assemblies has been listed where possible, but it is difficult to obtain or keep an accurate figure of workers or assemblies. However, we feel that even an approximate number can greatly help us here at home, to gain some understanding of the work. Many may not know that the American and Canadian workers comprise only about a third of the assembly missionaries in the world. Echoes of Service in England lists nearly 1200, and this does not include many who have gone to other lands primarily to serve the Lord, but are selfsupporting, and therefore are not on any list.

In listing the various types of work, we are unable to go into great detail, but take for granted that in most places, assembly activities include Bible teaching, evangelism, S.S., women's and children's work, visitation, etc. In areas of newly developed work, this is done extensively on a very local level. In other places with older work, national brethren take much of this responsibility, and the missionary travels throughout the area, teaching, encouraging and helping these local brethren.

In listing the children's names, we are including their age as of Jan. 1, 1967. An asterisk following the name, indicates that the child is in a boarding school, or away from the parents for the major portion of the year. In the back of the book is a list of the children, their birthdays, and the schools they attend, if away from home. We are now keeping the names of college age young people on the list, unless self-supporting. The separation from parents, and the tremendous pressure on college students today calls for increased prayer for both the student and his parents.

We would appreciate receiving any helpful suggestions or additional information or corrections.
